

AUTO CAMPERS LAUNCHES NEW VW CAMPER

Campervan manufacturer, Auto Campers, is now offering a conversion based on the new Volkswagen T6.

The news that it is to build on new Volkswagens follows the announcement that it is offering its Classic model on both used VW and Ford base vehicles (see February issue).

Now the award-winning campervan manufacturer has confirmed it will offer a new VW T6-based MRV. The MRV has a rising roof and a modular furniture system, plus optional bonded rails in the floor for flexibility of seat and bed combinations.

Auto Campers is also now working with Fix-Fork, a company in Belgium, which provides powder-coated brackets to safely transport bikes within a vehicle. Auto Campers uniquely uses a certified bonded floor to enable this.

An extended bracket allows bikes to be placed next to each other, with the handlebars sitting one above the other. The Fix-Fork bike brackets are typically fitted to an extruded aluminium rail, with various universal plates and fixtures to adapt the extrusion to any vehicle with adequate load space, including motorhomes with garages.
